



TEACH USA PROGRAM – ELIGIBILITY

To participate in this program you must:

- Be working as a teacher outside of the U.S. with at least two years of full-time teaching experience OR
- If not currently teaching, within 12 months of applying for the program, must have or will have received an advanced degree (beyond a U.S. bachelor's) in education or in the subject matter you intend to teach
- Be fluent in the English language
- Meet the qualification for teaching at the primary or secondary levels in schools in your home country
- Be of good reputation and character

ITP IN EDUCATION PROGRAM – ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Intern or Trainee program you must:

Intern

- Currently be a full-time student or
- A recent graduate (No more than 12 months ago) holding a post-secondary academic degree from an institution outside of the U.S.
- Speak fluent English
- Have an academic background matching your desired placement
- Commit to leave the U.S. within thirty (30) days following the last day of the J1 program

Trainee

- Be a recent graduate with at least one year of work experience in their field of study, or
- Be a professional with at least 5 years of work experience related to the field they are pursuing
- Speak excellent English

- Commit to leaving the U.S. within thirty (30) days following the last day of the J-1 program.

TEACH AUSTRALIA PROGRAM – ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the Teach Australia program, you must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- **Educational Background:** A bachelor's degree or higher in education.

Complete Education qualifications comparable to the educational level of an Australian Bachelor degree (Australian Qualifications Framework Level 7) or higher.

- **Supervised Teaching Practice:** An official statement from the university awarding the Teaching qualification is required as evidence of the length and nature of the supervised teaching practice undertaken as part of the curriculum.
- **Teaching Experience:** A minimum of 4 years of relevant teaching experience.
- **English Proficiency:** A minimum IELTS score of 7.5 overall is required.
- **Skills Assessment:** Successful completion of a skills assessment conducted by the Australian Institute for Teaching and School Leadership (AITSL), which evaluates your qualifications and English language proficiency.
- **Health Check:** A Health Check may be required to ensure your fitness for the role. Applicants will be notified after visa lodgement.
- **Background Check:** A national background check is required to ensure a safe and secure environment.

Working With Children Check (WWCC)

In addition to these requirements, all teachers must obtain a Working

With Children Clearance (WWCC) specific to the state or territory in which they plan to teach. This check ensures the safety of students and is a mandatory step before submitting your Teacher Registration. You must hold a valid WWCC notice for the Teacher Registration Boards to assess your suitability for the role. This is critical in ensuring the safety of the teaching environment and your ability to work with children in Australia.
